Please be sure to have nothing to eat or drink from midnight the night before.

Please report to the Ambulatory Surgery Unit one (1) hour prior to your scheduled surgery.

Be sure to have a driver to take you home from the hospital; you may not drive yourself.

If medical clearance is indicated for you, be sure to bring your clearance note to the unit the day of surgery.

The Ambulatory Surgical Unit is located up beyond the parking garage. It is a separate building with their own parking.

If the patient schedule for surgery is a child, it is important that they be given nothing by mouth from midnight the night before also. They may use a pacifier.

A pediatric medical clearance not is necessary on any child schedule for surgery.
