



Post Vasectomy Semen Analysis Instructions

After your vasectomy, you will be asked to produce a semen specimen to confirm that there is no sperm in your ejaculate. The specimen should be brought to a laboratory **two months** after the procedure. If the specimen shows that there is still sperm remaining in your semen, you will be asked to submit another sample in approximately one month. Until the semen analysis shows no evidence of any sperm, **you must continue to use protection.**

Post vasectomy semen specimens are brought to North Shore University Hospital Manhasset, Quest Laboratory or to any participating laboratory covered by your insurance company. Be sure your name is written on the specimen container. Specimen containers will be provided after your vasectomy.
