Dr. Badillo is Chief of Urology, St. Francis Hospital, Roslyn, and former Chief, Division of Robotic Urology, North Shore University Hospital, Manhasset.

Dr. Badillo is a clinical instructor of urology at Cornell University Medical College and a clinical assistant professor of urology at North Shore University Hospital. In addition to his private

practice, Dr. Badillo serves as Chief of Urology at St. Francis Hospital where he specializes in minimally invasive procedures, **such as laparoscopic and robotic surgery of the prostate, kidney, bladder, and adrenal gland.** He is a member of the Minimally Invasive Robotic Association, Society of Laparoscopic Surgeons, the Endourological Society, and is a member of the Medical Advisory Board of the National Kidney Foundation. Dr. Badillo was recognized as one of "America's Top Doctors - Urology 2004-2005, 2005-2006, 2006-2007, and 2007-2008" in the *Guide to America's Top Doctors* by the Consumer's Research Council of America.
