



















In addition, she is Clinical Associate Professor of Urology and Clinical Associate Professor of Reproductive Medicine at Cornell Medical Center.

Dr. Girardi has published numerous articles, book chapters, and reviews on male infertility, including varicocele, reconstructive surgery of the male reproductive tract, and the genetics of male infertility. Her research interests are the genetics of male infertility and reproductive endocrinology.
